

CRIME PREVENTION ADVICE
VULNERABLE PREMISES

There has recently been a spate of break-ins to premises such as Miners Welfare Clubs, Football Supporters Clubs and Golf Clubhouses. These have been occurring all over Scotland.

The premises are targeted by persons in advance who gain entry during opening hours and interfere with the alarm system so that it fails to set properly, mostly by damaging a door contact. Therefore, most premises are left with an inoperable alarm system allowing the thieves time to re-attend that evening. On most occasions safes and large quantities of money have been stolen.

It is imperative that the alarm company is contacted ***as soon as possible*** to fix the system to ensure the property is fully protected.

It is also important that your local Police Office is made aware of the problem with the alarm to allow us the opportunity to collate this information and the opportunity to **detect offenders**.
